

GENERAL RULES

- Annual membership will run from the 2nd January to 31st December each year
- Day tickets run from DAWN to DUSK
- 24hour overnight fishing starts from time ticket is issued
- Prior to commencing fishing all members are to check notice board (where applicable) and conversant with any changes to the rules relating to the use of these waters
- Members are to ensure their swim is free of litter and discarded items of tackle, line etc.
 before and after fishing their swim
- Litter and unused bate to be taken home and discarded DO NOT LEAVE BATE ON THE BANK
- All fish to be returned to the water in a responsible and safe manner without causing unnecessary stress or harm
- Fishing members are to respect a distance of 10 yards from each other
- On no account must alive or dead, fresh water fish be brought to use on these waters for pike fishing
- Bated rods are not to be left unattended at anytime
- Swimming, radios, music, boats and fires are not allowed at these waters
- All members to be aware that pleasure fishing will not be allowed prior to the start or during
 a club fishing match. Pleasure fishing can commence after the weigh in has been completed
- Land owner's property is to be respected at all times and members are not permit to damage, property, crops or live stock. In addition, members are not to trespass on land which is outside of the fishing compound.
- All motor vehicles are to be parked in designated area
- The landlord shall not be liable for any loss or injury sustained by a member or guest whilst fishing these waters
- It is the responsibility of all members to comply to all the rules stated in this document
- Junior members (under 16) are not permitted to fish unless accompanied by a responsible adult
- All hooks are to be barbless when fishing these waters, all members must ensure they are equipped with a landing mat and net
- No Carp must be kept in any keep nets
- All keep nets must be dipped on arrival in the net dip provided at the gate
- Any dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and dog foul must be removed
- All nut-based products are forbidden on these waters

FAILURE TO COMPLY TO THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF MEMBERSHIP AND YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY
